- WHEN:** 17th-19th May 2019
- WHERE:** In and around the village of Sherston.
- WHAT:** A POP up is a temporary, fun experience you hold in your own house, garden or temporary location (e.g. High Street or Village Hall). It can be anything from a product that you sell to a skill you can share.
- WHO:** Anyone who has a house in Sherston/Easton Grey (as we can include a cycle trail). If you don't have a house in the village, why not join with a friend or set up on the High Street or Village Hall.
- AGES:** Everyone – It's an all-age event! If your children want to run a POP, that's great so long as a responsible adult is on hand to supervise and look after their safety.
- POP IDEAS:** How about sushi-making or face-painting, running a bakery, milkshake bar or pretzel stand, sharing sporting skills, hosting a kids' teatime, morning coffee, afternoon tea or safari supper, holding a ballroom dancing class, jam-making masterclass or beauty salon, book shop, vintage furniture shop, organising music lessons, a piano bar, cinema, car valeting or beer tasting, or setting up a bacon butty breakfast van, lemonade stand or games café to name just a few!
- HOW:** Simple, think of an idea you've always wanted to run, fill in the form below and send it in by Thursday 28th March. The POP team will compile the entries into a workable timetable. We will try to make sure every POP is well attended so there might be a little bit of shuffling if we get, say, 10 coffee shops that all want to open at the same time.
- PROCEEDS:** Any money you make (after costs) will be donated to our two charities: Friends of Sherston School and Sherston Village Hall.
- COST:** £10 per POP, the POP team will use the entry fee to cover the costs of publicity materials (map, timetable, website). Anything left over will be donated to the charities. This is a cost to you so you can, if you wish, take this out of your profit. So the only thing a POP will cost you is your time!
- POP:** The idea behind POP up is that the person running the POP is entirely responsible for the organisation and running of their own event and all related matters. You're in the driving seat!
